

City of Cody
Council Proceedings
Thursday, March 29, 2012

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in City Council Chambers at City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, March 29, 2012 at 3:45 p.m.

Present: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown, Council Members Steve Miller, Donny Anderson, Charles Cloud, Jerry Fritz and Bryan Edwards, City Attorney, Scott Kolpitcke, and Administrative Services Officer, Cindy Baker

Absent: City Administrator, Jenni Rosencranse

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 3:45 p.m.

Council Member Miller made a motion seconded by Council Member Cloud to remove from the table and enter as the first item of the agenda consideration of the request to issue the City's unissued retail liquor license to one of the following five applicants: Edwin E. Higbie Jr. dba Rusty Spur, Pat O'Hara Brewing Co, LLC dba Pat O'Hara Brewing Co LLC, Diehl Enterprises, Inc dba Chamberlin Inn, Walmart Stores, Inc. dba Walmart, and TLJ, LLC dba La Comida. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Cloud made a motion seconded by Council Member Fritz made a motion to award the unissued retail liquor license to Pat O'Hara Brewing Co. LLC dba Pat O'Hara Brewing Co. LLC. Those voting in favor were Council Members Cloud, Wolz, and Fritz. Those opposed were Council Members Anderson, Miller, Edwards and Mayor Brown. Motion failed.

Council Member Wolz made a motion seconded by Council Member Anderson to award the unissued retail liquor license to Diehl Enterprises, Inc dba Chamberlin Inn. Those voting in favor were Council Member Anderson, Miller, Wolz and Mayor Brown. Those opposed Council Members Cloud, Fritz and Edwards. Motion passed.

Council Member Miller made a motion seconded by Council Member Cloud to authorize the Council to sign Letters of Appreciation for Governor Mead, Representatives Pat Childers and Sam Krone and Senator Hank Coe. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Miller made a motion seconded by Council Member Fritz to authorize the Mayor to enter into and sign an Interim Power Supply Agreement between the City of Cody, Rocky Mountain Power, Harris Trucking and Cody Meat, subject to a review of the agreement by the City Attorney. Vote was unanimous.

The Governing Body discussed a request from Hollis Jones to plant a Community Garden on property south of property addressed as 1448 Alger Ave. Steve Payne, Public Works Director provided history of the usage of this area and indicated the location is no longer used by the Sanitation Dept or the Fire Department. Mr. Jones informed the Governing Body of his plans to use the garden as a teaching tool and hopes to partner with the Kidz on the Move, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts or other community youth groups. Staff was directed to add this item to the April 3rd Council Agenda.

The Governing Body discussed an easement for garbage collection and utilities north of Huff & Puff between 14th and Heart Mountain. Todd Stowell, City Planner provided the Council with the situation that developed in this area and why this has come to the City's attention. Staff was directed to add an item to the April 3rd Council Agenda requesting authorization for a survey and bring findings back to the Council at a later date.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Recreation & Facilities Director, presented the Governing Body with a request to redirect budgeted funds in the Parks and Recreation Division. The item originally budgeted for is no longer available and several other items, not exceeding the budgeted amount, would be purchased in its place. Council agreed the redirection of funds was appropriate.

The Governing Body discuss agenda for April 3, 2012 Council Meeting. Staff was directed to make revisions as discussed. No action was taken.

There being no further discussion, the meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
