

**City of Cody**  
**Council Proceedings**  
**Thursday, April 12, 2012**

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in City Council Chambers at City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, April 12, 2012 at 3:45 p.m.

Present: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown, Council Members Steve Miller, Donny Anderson, Jerry Fritz and City Administrator, Jenni Rosencranse, City Attorney, Scott Kolpitcke, and Administrative Services Officer, Cindy Baker

Absent: Council Members Bryan Edwards and Charles Cloud.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Facilities and Recreation Director provided the Governing Body with background information on the Optimist Club wanting to hold a Children's Festival in City Park. Staff was directed to prepare an agenda request and bring to the Council meeting on Tuesday, April 17<sup>th</sup>. No action was taken.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Facilities and Recreation Director provided information on the Legion Baseball Field Improvements that the Cody Legion Baseball group would like to proceed with. Staff was instructed to prepare an agenda request and bring to the Council meeting on Tuesday, April 17<sup>th</sup>. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed the recent vandalism to a skylight in Nichol Mall. Staff was directed to go ahead with the repairs, cost will be covered out of the Council's contingency fund.

Jenni Rosencranse provided the Council with background information on the CDBG process and the request from Lisa Peterman in reference to future grant request for a new building for Crisis Intervention. Staff was directed to meet with Crisis Intervention Staff and Habitat for Humanity Staff and review options available for both. No action was taken.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director provided information on the City's ISO rating. No action was taken.

Jenni Rosencranse, City Administrator updated the Governing Body on the Topsy Taxi program and discussion was held on the next season for this program. No action was taken.

Council Member Miller made a motion seconded by Council Member Wolz to authorize the Mayor to sign a Special Use Permit with the United States Department of Interior – Bureau of Reclamation. Vote was unanimous.
